Terms and Conditions of Entry

Please note this is a themed exhibition:

Work can be made in any media (E.G; photos, paintings, ceramics, drawing etc.) **but they must fit in with the following theme – MATARIKI in a respectful and appropriate way (for research find links on page 2)**

Matariki is the name for the small cluster of nine stars that rise in late June/July, marking the beginning of the new year in the Maori lunar calendar. The name Matariki, (translated to English, means the 'eyes of the god') is the name for one of the stars as well as the whole cluster.

***One artwork can be entered.**

***Artworks must not have been entered into a previous exhibition at Kumeū Arts**

***Exhibition is open to fully paid up Kumeū Arts members**

***All sold work will incur a 34.5% commission fee.** Fees will be deducted from the artist's payment at the end of the exhibition. Any tax liability is the responsibility of the artist.

***All entry forms must be FULLY completed, including pricing.** Incomplete entry forms and late entries will not be accepted. Any changes to be notified to Kumeū Arts on or before the delivery date, no late changes will be accepted.

***Work to be delivered to the coordinator/nominee on the given dates/times and must be:**

-Suitably packaged with bubble wrap, cardboard or boxed. While all care will be taken, Kumeū Arts will not accept responsibility for loss or damage while the work is in transit or while being exhibited. **Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.**

-Suitably prepared for display i.e. mounted and/or framed, with hangers and tightly strung with string/cord. In the event that we have to string artwork, a \$5 fee will be charged. Clearly labelled with the artist's name and title of work.

***If work is not of a suitable standard or appropriate for display the curator may decide not to include it.** No correspondence will be entered into and their decision is final.

***Unsold work to be collected by the given date.** Kumeū Arts has very limited storage space therefore work not collected within 2 days of the given date will incur a \$10 per day storage fee.

Work remaining uncollected after 2 months will become the property of Kumeū Arts.

Images of exhibited works may be used by Kumeū Arts for publicity purposes.
